SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Department of Employment Security for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, as follows:

General Funds	\$165,055,000
Other State Funds	\$ 4,000,000
Federal Funds	\$455,032,100
Total	\$624,087,100

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1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1

Section 5. In addition to any other sums appropriated, the sum of \$405,122,800 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Title III Social Security and Employment Fund to the Department of Employment Security for operational expenses, awards, grants, and permanent improvements for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, including prior year costs.

Section 10. The sum of \$60,000,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Employment Security for deposit into the Title III Social Security and Employment Fund for operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024.

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Section 15. The following named sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Department of Employment Security:

19	Section 30. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as may
20	be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
21	the Department of Employment Security for all ordinary and
22	contingent expenses related to the implementation of Automatic
23	Voter Registration.

1	Section 35. The amount of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof
2	as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Unemployment
3	Compensation Special Administration Fund to the Department of
4	Employment Security for the payment of interest on advances
5	made to the Unemployment Trust Fund as required by Title XII
6	of the Social Security Act.

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Section 40. The amount of \$8,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Employment Security for deposit into the Title III Social Security and Employment Fund for the payment of interest on advances made to the Unemployment Trust Fund as required by Title XII of the Social Security Act.

Section 45. The amount of \$75,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Employment Security for the return of federal funds to the Federal Emergency Management Agency in accordance with 44 C.F.R. § 206.120(f).

Section 50. The amount of \$700,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Employment Security for data analysis and administrative expenses associated with the Homelessness

2 prevention strategies.

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4 Section 55. The amount of \$155,000, or so much thereof as

5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund

6 to the Department of Employment Security to implement

7 diversity, equity and inclusion initiatives.

8 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
