2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 3413, AS AMENDED,  
3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No.  
4 1, on page 4, lines 2 and 3, by replacing ", 17, and 18" with  
5 "and 17"; and

6 on page 6, by replacing lines 9 through 12 with the following:  
7 "Natural Resources prior to their removal. ~~Nothing in this Act~~  
8 ~~shall be~~"; and

9 on page 7, line 1, by deleting "federal"; and

10 on page 7, by replacing lines 2 through 6 with the following:  
11 "status of tribes. Despite the State of Illinois' long"; and

12 on page 7, by replacing lines 13 through 21 with the following:  
13 "archeological sites, burial grounds, and mounds. The types of  
14 activities that may affect properties of religious and

1 cultural significance include: actions taken to disturb the  
2 ground and new construction in underdeveloped natural areas.";

4 on page 9, by replacing lines 8 and 9 with the following:

14 and all work must immediately cease, and within 48 hours, the  
15 Department of Natural Resources must be notified and"; and

16 on page 10, lines 14 and 15, by deleting ", as provided in the  
17 National Historic Preservation Act of 1966,"; and

18 on page 11, by replacing lines 13 and 14 with the following:

19 "occur, a land permit must be obtained from the Department of  
20 Natural Resources, and the State Burial Coordinator shall  
21 determine whether the grave that is to be disturbed is a Native  
22 American grave. When a land permit request is received, the";

2 on page 11, by replacing line 23 with the following:

3 by replacing line 23 on page 17 through line 22 on page 18 with  
4 the following:

5 "(20 ILCS 3440/2 rep.)

6 (20 ILCS 3440/4.75 rep.)

7 (20 ILCS 3440/11 rep.)

8 Section 15. The Human Skeletal Remains Protection Act is  
9 amended by repealing Sections 2, 4.75, and 11."
