- 11 (a) On request, a participating employee subject to this

- 15 authorized by the employer or a collective bargaining
- 16 agreement, to donate blood every 56 days in accordance with
- appropriate medical standards established by the American Red 17
- 18 Cross, America's Blood Centers, the American Association of
- 19 Blood Banks, or other nationally recognized standards.
- 20 (b-5) An employee may use up to 10 days of leave in any

- (d) The Department must adopt rules governing blood 3 donation leave taken to donate blood, an organ, or bone marrow, including rules that (i) establish conditions and 4
- 5 procedures for requesting and approving leave and (ii) require
- 6 medical documentation of the proposed blood, organ, or bone
- 7 marrow donation before leave is approved by the employer.
