1 AN ACT concerning business.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business
 Practices Act is amended by adding Section 2BBBB as follows:
- 6 (815 ILCS 505/2BBBB new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 2BBBB. Gas stoves.</u>
- 8 (a) As used in this Section, "gas stove" means a household
 9 natural gas stove or range that is used for food preparation
- and provides at least one of the following functions:
- 11 (1) surface cooking;
- 12 (2) oven cooking; or
- 13 (3) broiling.
- 14 (b) No person shall sell, attempt to sell, or offer to sell

 15 to a consumer in this State a gas stove that is manufactured on

 16 or after January 1, 2024 unless a label on the gas stove bears

 17 the message:
- MARNING: Gas stoves can release nitrogen dioxide and carbon monoxide inside homes at levels exceeding the EPA's standards for outdoor air quality. The presence of these pollutants may exacerbate pre-existing respiratory illnesses or lead to the development of asthma, especially in children. Gas powered stoves should never be used

1	without a ducted vent hood to reduce exposure to these
2	emissions.
3	The label shall be attached to the gas stove in a
4	conspicuous location. The label must be in a type size no
5	smaller than the largest type size used for other consumer
6	information on the product. The Attorney General may adopt
7	rules regarding the placement and format of the label.
