A BILL FOR

AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented 2 in the General Assembly: 3

Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much of those 4 5 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes named, are appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 6 to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of 7 8 the State Appellate Defender.

2 Section 15. The amount of \$111,000, or so much of that sum 3 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 4 Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to provide 5 statewide training to Public Defenders under the Public 6 Defender Training Program.

Section 20. The amount of \$514,700, or so much of that sum as may be necessary, is appropriated from General Revenue Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to develop a Juvenile Defender Resource Center.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
