1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4264 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 4264 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the 4 5 Menstrual Products Donor Immunity Act. 6 Section 5. Definitions. As used in this Act: "Apparently usable" means, with respect to the product, 7 that the product meets all quality and labeling standards 8 imposed by federal, State, and local laws, rules, and 9 regulations, even if the product may not be readily 10 11 marketable. 12 "Donor" means a nonprofit organization that donates an 13 apparently usable menstrual product to a human recipient for ultimate use with respect to menstruation. 14 15 "Menstrual product" means a sanitary napkin, tampon,

liner, cup, and any similar item used by an individual with

- 1 respect to menstruation.
- 2 Section 10. Nonprofit organization immunity from
- 3 liability. A nonprofit organization that in good faith
- 4 receives menstrual products for distribution without fee or
- compensation and reasonably inspects the menstrual product at 5
- the time of donation and finds the menstrual product 6
- 7 apparently usable for humans shall not be liable in any civil
- 8 action, except for willful or wanton conduct.
- 9 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- becoming law.". 10
