Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Renewable Energy, Energy Efficiency, and
Coal Resources Development Law of 1997 is amended by changing
Section 6-2 as follows:

9 Sec. 6-2. Findings and intent. The The General Assembly finds and declares that it is desirable to obtain the 10 environmental quality, public health, and fuel diversity 11 12 benefits of developing new renewable energy resources and clean coal technologies for use in Illinois and to lower the 13 14 cost of renewable energy resources and clean coal resources provided to utility consumers. The General Assembly finds and 15 16 declares that the benefits of electricity from renewable 17 energy resources and clean coal technologies accrue to the public at large, thus consumers and electric utilities and 18 19 alternative retail electric suppliers share an interest in 20 developing and using a significant level of these 21 environmentally preferable resources in the State's 22 electricity supply portfolio. The General Assembly finds and declares that encouraging energy efficiency will improve the 23
