2	AMENDMENT NO Amend House Bill 4535 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4	"Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
5	changing Sections 3-651, 3-698, and 3-699.15 as follows:

7	Sec. 3-651. U.S. Marine Corps license plates.
8	(a) In addition to any other special license plate, the
9	Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and
10	applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of
11	State, may issue special registration plates designated as
12	U.S. Marine Corps license plates to residents of Illinois who
13	meet eligibility requirements prescribed by the Secretary of
14	State. The special plate issued under this Section shall be
15	affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division,
16	motorcycles, motor vehicles of the second division weighing

not more than 8,000 pounds, and recreational vehicles as defined by Section 1-169 of this Code. Plates issued under this Section shall expire according to the staggered multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

(b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be 6 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State, except 7 8 that the U.S. Marine Corps emblem shall appear on the plates. 9 The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates 10 to be issued as vanity or personalized plates in accordance 11 with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection 12 13 (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall 14 prescribe the eligibility requirements and, in his or her 15 discretion, shall approve and prescribe stickers or decals as 16 provided under Section 3-412.

(c) An applicant shall be charged a \$5 fee for original issuance in addition to the applicable registration fee. This additional fee shall be deposited into the Marine Corps Scholarship Fund. For each registration renewal period, an \$18 fee, in addition to the appropriate registration fee, shall be charged. This additional fee shall be deposited into the Marine Corps Scholarship Fund.

24 <u>The Secretary of State shall waive any additional fees</u> 25 <u>under this subsection if the individual requesting the license</u> 26 <u>plate:</u> 1

(1) requests that the additional fees be waived; and

(2) is serving or has served in any branch of the United States Armed Forces, including the National Guard or other reserve components of the Armed Forces.

5 (d) The Marine Corps Scholarship Fund is created as a special fund in the State treasury. All moneys in the Marine 6 Corps Scholarship Fund shall, subject to appropriation by the 7 8 General Assembly and distribution by the Secretary, be used by 9 the Marine Corps Coordinating Council of Illinois, Inc., a 10 recognized charitable organization that meets the requirements 11 of Title 26, Section 501(c)(3) of the United States Code, to provide grants for scholarships for higher education. The 12 13 scholarship recipients must be the children of current or former members of the United States Marine Corps who meet the 14 15 academic, financial, and other requirements established by the 16 Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation. addition, In the recipients must be Illinois residents and must attend a 17 18 college or university located within the State of Illinois.

(e) In addition, the Marine Corps Coordinating Council of 19 20 Illinois is authorized to provide grants to the Marine Corps 21 Scholarship Foundation, the Young Marine National Foundation, 22 the Women Marines Association, and to any local chapter of the 23 Marine Corps League that is located in Illinois. Any grant 24 money paid from the Marine Corps Scholarship Fund shall be 25 used for scholarships for undergraduate, graduate, and career 26 technical education and certification, financial and

assistance, or monetary awards to veterans or veterans'
 families that are located within the State of Illinois.

5 Sec. 3-698. U.S. Air Force license plates.

(a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and 6 7 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may issue special registration plates designated as 8 9 U.S. Air Force license plates to residents of Illinois who 10 meet eligibility requirements prescribed by the Secretary of State. The special plate issued under this Section shall be 11 affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, 12 motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 13 14 8,000 pounds, and recreational vehicles as defined by Section 15 1-169 of this Code. Plates issued under this Section shall expire according to the multi-year procedure established by 16 Section 3-414.1 of this Code. 17

18 (b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be 19 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State, except 20 that the U.S. Air Force emblem shall appear on the plates. The 21 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be 22 issued as vanity or personalized plates in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to 23 24 designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe 25

the eligibility requirements and, in his or her discretion, shall approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided under Section 3-412.

4 (c) An applicant shall be charged a \$20 fee for original 5 issuance in addition to the applicable registration fee. Of this additional fee, \$15 shall be deposited into the Secretary 6 of State Special License Plate Fund and \$5 shall be deposited 7 8 into the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund. For each 9 registration renewal period, a \$20 fee, in addition to the 10 appropriate registration fee, shall be charged. Of this 11 additional fee, \$2 shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund and \$18 shall be deposited 12 13 into the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund.

14The Secretary of State shall waive any additional fees15under this subsection if the individual requesting the license16plate:

17 <u>(1) requests that the additional fees be waived; and</u>
18 <u>(2) is serving or has served in any branch of the</u>
19 <u>United States Armed Forces, including the National Guard</u>
20 <u>or other reserve components of the Armed Forces.</u>

(d) The Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund is created as a special fund in the State treasury. Sec. 3-699.15. Coast Guard license plates.

8 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and 9 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of 10 State, may issue special registration plates designated as U.S. Coast Guard plates. The special plates issued under this 11 12 Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division or motor vehicles of the second division 13 14 weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates under this Section 15 shall expire according to the multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code. 16

(b) The design and color of the special plates shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. Appropriate documentation, as determined by the Secretary, shall accompany each application.

(c) An applicant shall be charged a \$26 fee for the original issuance in addition to the appropriate registration fee, if applicable. Of this fee, \$11 shall be deposited into the Illinois Veterans' Homes Fund and \$15 shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.
