3	on page 19, line 9, by deleting "2-102," and "7-101,"; and

5	by deleting line 20 on page 35 through line 10 on page 38; and
6	on page 56, below line 21, by inserting the following:
7	"Section 6. The Illinois Human Rights Act is amended by
8	changing Section 7-101 as follows:
9	(775 ILCS 5/7-101) (from Ch. 68, par. 7-101)
10	Sec. 7-101. Powers and duties. In addition to other powers
11	and duties prescribed in this Act, the Department shall have
12	the following powers:

- 1 (A) Rules and Regulations. To adopt, promulgate, amend,
- 2 and rescind rules and regulations not inconsistent with the
- 3 provisions of this Act pursuant to the Illinois Administrative
- 4 Procedure Act.
- 5 (B) Charges. To issue, receive, investigate, conciliate,
- 6 settle, and dismiss charges filed in conformity with this Act.
- 7 (C) Compulsory Process. To request subpoenas as it deems
- 8 necessary for its investigations.
- 9 (D) Complaints. To file complaints with the Commission in
- 10 conformity with this Act and to intervene in complaints
- pending before the Commission filed under Article 2, 4, 5, 5A,
- 12 or 6.
- 13 (E) Judicial Enforcement. To seek temporary relief and to
- enforce orders of the Commission in conformity with this Act.
- 15 (F) Equal Employment Opportunities. To take such action as
- 16 may be authorized to provide for equal employment
- 17 opportunities and affirmative action.
- 18 (G) Recruitment; Research; Public Communication; Advisory
- 19 Councils. To engage in such recruitment, research and public
- 20 communication and create such advisory councils as may be
- 21 authorized to effectuate the purposes of this Act.
- 22 (H) Coordination with other Agencies. To coordinate its
- 23 activities with federal, state, and local agencies in
- conformity with this Act.
- 25 (I) Grants; Private Gifts.
- 26 (1) To accept public grants and private gifts as may

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- 2 (2) To design grant programs and award grants to eligible recipients.
 - (J) Education and Training. To implement a formal and unbiased program of education and training for all employees assigned to investigate and conciliate charges under Articles 7A and 7B. The training program shall include the following:
 - (1) substantive and procedural aspects of the investigation and conciliation positions;
 - (2) current issues in human rights law and practice;
 - (3) lectures by specialists in substantive areas related to human rights matters;
 - (4) orientation to each operational unit of the Department and Commission;
 - (5) observation of experienced Department investigators and attorneys conducting conciliation conferences, combined with the opportunity to discuss evidence presented and rulings made;
 - (6) the use of hypothetical cases requiring the Department investigator and conciliation conference attorney to issue judgments as a means to evaluating knowledge and writing ability;
 - (7) writing skills;
- 24 (8) computer skills, including but not limited to word 25 processing and document management.
- 26 A formal, unbiased and ongoing professional development

- 1 program including, but not limited to, the above-noted areas
- 2 shall be implemented to keep Department investigators and
- 3 attorneys informed of recent developments and issues and to
- 4 assist them in maintaining and enhancing their professional
- 5 competence.
- 6 (K) Hotlines. To establish and maintain hotlines and
- 7 helplines to aid in effectuating the purposes of this Act
- 8 including the confidential reporting of discrimination,
- 9 harassment, and bias incidents. All communications received or
- sent via the hotlines and helplines are exempt from disclosure
- 11 under the Freedom of Information Act.
