Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much thereof 6 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes 7 hereinafter named, are appropriated from the General Revenue 8 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for ordinary and 9 contingent expenses:

1 Section 10. The sum of \$1,348,420, or so much thereof as 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 3 to Illinois Community College Board for costs associated with 4 administering high school equivalency tests.

5 Section 15. The sum of \$4,000,000, or so much thereof as 6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 7 to the Illinois Community College Board for grants to the 8 alternative schools network and other providers.

9 Section 20. The sum of \$60,200, or so much thereof as may 10 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 11 the Illinois Community College Board for awarding scholarships 12 to qualifying graduates of the Lincoln's Challenge Program.

Section 25. The sum of \$15,201,800, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for the City Colleges of Chicago for educational-related expenses.

17 Section 30. The following named amounts, or so much thereof 18 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the 19 General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board 20 for distribution to qualifying public community colleges for HB5719 -3- OMB103 00393 KMH 45393 b 1 the purposes specified:

5 Section 35. The sum of \$650,360, or so much thereof as may 6 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 7 the Illinois Community College Board for costs associated with 8 the development, support or administration of the Illinois 9 Longitudinal Data System.

10 Section 40. The sum of \$1,447,900, or so much thereof as 11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 12 to the Illinois Community College Board to operate an 13 educational facility in the former community college district 14 #541 in East St. Louis.

15 Section 45. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as 16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 17 to the Illinois Community College Board for costs associated 18 with transitional and developmental instruction.

Section 50. The sum of \$28,794,400, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for all costs HB5719 -4- OMB103 00393 KMH 45393 b associated with the bridge and workforce programs.

2 Section 51. The sum of \$5,900,000, or so much thereof as 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 4 to the Illinois Community College Board for Southwestern 5 Illinois College to operate an educational facility in the 6 former Lindenwood University campus in Belleville.

Section 52. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs associated with trade schools.

6 Section 70. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as may 7 be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Research and Technology Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for 8 9 costs associated with maintaining and updating instructional 10 technology.

11 Section 75. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as may 12 be necessary, is appropriated from the High School Equivalency 13 Testing Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs associated with administering high school equivalency tests. 14

Section 80. The sum of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof as 15 16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Community College Board Contracts and Grants Fund to the Illinois 17 18 Community College Board to be expended under the terms and 19 conditions associated with the moneys being received, including 20 prior years' expenditures.

21 Section 85. The sum of \$625,000, or so much thereof as may 22 be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Federal Trust Fund HB5719 -7- OMB103 00393 KMH 45393 b 1 to the Illinois Community College Board for the ordinary and 2 contingent expenses of the Board.

3 Section 90. The sum of \$1,600,000, or so much thereof as 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Adult Education 5 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for operational 6 expenses associated with administration of adult education and 7 literacy activities.

8 Section 95. The sum of \$4,264,400, or so much thereof as 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 10 to the Illinois Community College Board to reimburse colleges 11 for costs associated with the Illinois Veterans Grant and 12 Illinois National Guard Grant.

Section 100. The sum of \$20,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for the Pipeline for Advancement of the Healthcare (PATH) Workforce Program.

Section 105. The sum of \$175,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for operational expenses associated with the PATH Workforce Program. -8- OMB103 00393 KMH 45393 b

Section 110. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for the administration and distribution of grants for the implementation of the Mental Health Early Action on Campus Act.

Section 115. The sum of \$9,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs associated with advanced manufacturing and electric vehicle technologies programs.

Section 120. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs associated with digital instruction for Title II adult education.

Section 125. The sum of \$750,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs associated with the expansion of English-language services.

20 Section 130. The sum of \$3,175,000, or so much thereof as 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 22 to the Illinois Community College Board for grants and

2 Section 135. The sum of \$5,175,000, or so much thereof as 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 4 to the Illinois Community College Board for grants and 5 administrative costs associated with non-credit workforce 6 programs.

Section 140. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for grants and administrative costs associated with the community college Homelessness Prevention Grant program.

Section 145. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for operational expenses associated with grant management.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2024.
