1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of 3 Representatives wish to congratulate Sarah F. King on her 4 installation as president of the Women's Bar Association of 5 Illinois (WBAI); and

WHEREAS, The WBAI was first established in 1914 by nine women lawyers practicing in the Chicago metropolitan area; one of the oldest and largest bar associations in the State of Illinois, it serves as an influential voice in promoting the interests and welfare of women in the law, offering mentorship and networking opportunities, career advice, and events that promote and empower women leaders; and

WHEREAS, Sarah King earned her Bachelor of Arts from Loyola University Chicago in 2008; she earned her Juris Doctor from DePaul University College of Law in 2011, where she was inducted into the Order of the Coif; and

WHEREAS, A staunch advocate for women's rights and a supporter of women in law, Sarah King understands the opportunity she has as a woman trial lawyer to create positive changes in the judicial system by fostering equality and inclusion for women both inside and outside the courtroom; the theme for the 2024-2025 bar year is Together, In Service, with a strong focus on serving members through programming and
