- 7 Sec. 11-502.1. Possession of medical cannabis in a motor 8 vehicle.
- 9 (a) No driver, who is a medical cannabis cardholder, may
 10 use medical cannabis within the passenger area of any motor

 - (b) No driver, who is a medical cannabis cardholder, a medical cannabis designated caregiver, medical cannabis cultivation center agent, or dispensing organization agent may possess medical cannabis within any area of any motor vehicle upon a highway in this State except in a secured, sealed or resealable, odor proof, and child-resistant medical cannabis container that is inaccessible.
- 19 (c) No passenger, who is a medical cannabis card holder, a
 20 medical cannabis designated caregiver, or medical cannabis
 21 dispensing organization agent may possess medical cannabis
 22 within any passenger area of any motor vehicle upon a highway
 23 in this State except in a secured, sealed or resealable,
