## 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Public Employee Disability Act is amended
by adding Section 2 as follows:

6 (5 ILCS 345/2 new)

- 7 <u>Sec. 2. Illness disability benefit.</u>
- 8 (a) As used in this Section:

9 "Eligible employee" means any full-time law enforcement officer or full-time firefighter, including a full-time 10 paramedic or a firefighter who performs paramedic duties, who 11 is employed by any unit of local government, including any 12 home rule unit. 13 14 "Illness" means any illness, disease, or condition the presence of which in a community results in the declaration of 15 16 a disaster or emergency by a State, county, or municipal 17 official.

18 (b) Whenever an eligible employee suffers an illness in 19 the line of duty which causes the employee to be unable to 20 perform the employee's duties, the employee shall continue to 21 be paid by the employing public entity on the same basis as the 22 employee was paid before the illness, with no deduction from 23 the employee's sick leave credits, compensatory time for SB0214 Engrossed - 2 - LRB103 05995 DTM 51019 b

1 <u>overtime accumulations or vacation, or service credits in a</u>
2 <u>public pension fund during the time the employee is unable to</u>
3 <u>perform the employee's duties due to the result of the</u>
4 <u>illness, but not longer than one year in relation to the same</u>
5 <u>illness.</u>

6 <u>(c) At any time during the period for which continuing</u> 7 <u>compensation is required by this Act, the employing public</u> 8 <u>entity may order at the expense of that entity physical or</u> 9 <u>medical examinations of the ill person to determine the degree</u> 10 <u>of disability.</u>

11 (d) During this period of disability, the ill person shall 12 not be employed in any other manner, with or without a monetary compensation. Any person who is employed in violation of this 13 14 subsection forfeits the continuing compensation provided by this Act from the time such employment begins. Any salary 15 compensation due to the ill person from workers' compensation 16 17 or any salary due to the employee from any type of insurance which may be carried by the employing public entity shall 18 19 revert to that entity during the time for which continuing 20 compensation is paid to the employee under this Act. Any person with a disability receiving compensation under the 21 22 provisions of this Act shall not be entitled to any benefits for which the employee would qualify because of the employee's 23 24 disability under the provisions of the Illinois Pension Code. 25 (e) Pursuant to paragraphs (h) and (i) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution, this Act 26

2	of any power which is inconsistent herewith, and all existing
