1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1070

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 1070 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The University of Illinois Act is amended by  
5 changing Section 9 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 305/9) (from Ch. 144, par. 30)

7 Sec. 9. Scholarships for children of veterans. For each of  
8 the following periods of hostilities, each county shall be  
9 entitled, annually, to one honorary scholarship in the  
10 University, for the benefit of the children of persons who  
11 served in the armed forces of the United States, except that  
12 the total number of scholarships annually granted to  
13 recipients from each county may not exceed 3: any time between  
14 September 16, 1940 and the termination of World War II, any  
15 time during the national emergency between June 25, 1950 and  
16 January 31, 1955, any time during the Viet Nam conflict

1 between January 1, 1961 and May 7, 1975, any time during the  
2 siege of Beirut and the Grenada Conflict between June 14, 1982  
3 and December 15, 1983, or any time on or after August 2, 1990  
4 and until Congress or the President orders that persons in  
5 service are no longer eligible for the Southwest Asia Service  
6 Medal, the Kosovo Campaign Medal, or the Armed Forces  
7 Expeditionary Medal, Operation Enduring Freedom, and Operation  
8 Iraqi Freedom. Preference for scholarships shall be given to  
9 the children of persons who are deceased or to the children of  
10 persons who have a disability. Such scholarships shall be  
11 granted to such pupils as shall, upon public examination,  
12 conducted as the board of trustees of the University may  
13 determine, be decided to have attained the greatest  
14 proficiency in the branches of learning usually taught in the  
15 secondary schools, and who shall be of good moral character,  
16 and not less than 15 years of age. Such pupils, so selected,  
17 shall be entitled to receive, without charge for tuition,  
18 instruction in any or all departments of the University for a  
19 term of at least 4 consecutive years. Such pupils shall  
20 conform, in all respects, to the rules and regulations of the  
21 University, established for the government of the pupils in  
22 attendance.
