SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/10-20.85 new
105 ILCS 5/34-18.82 new

Amends the School Code. Requires a school board to adopt a policy to ensure that the parent or guardian of a student is provided with an opportunity to review the curricula and learning material used in the student's classroom at any point during the school year if the parent or guardian requests to review the curricula and learning material. Requires the policy to be published in the student handbook and on the school district's Internet website if one is maintained. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections
5 10-20.85 and 34-18.82 as follows:

7 Sec. 10-20.85. Parental review of learning material.

8 (a) A school board shall adopt a policy to ensure that the
9 parent or guardian of a student is provided with an
10 opportunity to review the curricula and learning material used
11 in the student's classroom at any point during the school year
12 if the parent or guardian requests to review the curricula and
13 learning material.

14 (b) The policy adopted under subsection (a) must be
15 published in the student handbook and on the school district's

18 Sec. 34-18.82. Parental review of learning material.

19 (a) The board shall adopt a policy to ensure that the
20 parent or guardian of a student is provided with an
21 opportunity to review the curricula and learning material used
22 in the student's classroom at any point during the school year

1 if the parent or guardian requests to review the curricula and
2 learning material.

3 (b) The policy adopted under subsection (a) must be
4 published in the student handbook and on the school district's

6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
7 becoming law.
