9	"Drive-through window in close proximity" means an
10	area contiguous to the restricted access area.
11	"Pickup-location in close proximity" means an area
12	contiguous to the real property of the dispensary, such as
13	a sidewalk or parking lot;"; and

- "Sections 5-45 and 40-5"; and 2
- 3 on page 147, immediately below line 15, by inserting the
- 4 following:

- "(410 ILCS 705/5-45) 5
- 6 Sec. 5-45. Illinois Cannabis Regulation Oversight Officer.
- 7 (a) The position of Illinois Cannabis Regulation Oversight 8 Officer is created within the Department of Financial and 9 Professional Regulation under the Secretary of Financial and Professional Regulation. The Cannabis Regulation Oversight 10 11 Officer serves a coordinating role among State agencies 12 regarding this Act and the Compassionate Use of Medical 13 Cannabis Program Act. The Illinois Cannabis Regulation 14 Oversight Officer shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate. The term of office of the 15 Officer shall expire on the third Monday of January in 16 odd-numbered years provided that he or she shall hold office 17 18 until a successor is appointed and qualified. In case of vacancy in office during the recess of the Senate, the 19 20 Governor shall make a temporary appointment until the next 21 meeting of the Senate, when the Governor shall nominate some 22 person to fill the office, and any person so nominated who is 23 confirmed by the Senate shall hold office during the remainder

of the term and until his or her successor is appointed and

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- 2 (b) The Illinois Cannabis Regulation Oversight Officer has
- 3 the authority to:
  - (1) maintain a staff;
- 5 (2) make recommendations for administrative and statutory changes;
- 7 (3) collect data both in Illinois and outside Illinois 8 regarding the regulation of cannabis;
  - (4) compile or assist in the compilation of any reports required by this Act;
- 11 (5) ensure the coordination of efforts between various 12 State agencies involved in regulating and taxing the sale 13 of cannabis in Illinois; and
- 14 (6) encourage, promote, suggest, and report best
  15 practices for ensuring diversity in the cannabis industry
  16 in Illinois.
- 17 (c) The Illinois Cannabis Regulation Oversight Officer and 18 the Officer's staff shall not:
- 19 (1) participate in the issuance or award of any cannabis business establishment license; or
- 21 (2) participate in discipline related to any cannabis 22 business establishment.
- 23 The Illinois Cannabis Regulation Officer is not prohibited 24 from coordinating with and making recommendations to agencies 25 regarding licensing and disciplinary policies and procedures.
- 26 (d) Any funding required for the Illinois Cannabis

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Regulation Oversight Officer, its staff, or its activities 1 shall be drawn from the Cannabis Regulation Fund.

(e) The Illinois Cannabis Regulation Oversight Officer shall commission and publish one or more disparity and availability studies that: (1) evaluates whether there exists discrimination in the State's cannabis industry; and (2) if so, evaluates the impact of such discrimination on the State and includes recommendations to the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation and the Department of Agriculture for reducing or eliminating any identified barriers to entry in the cannabis market. Such disparity and availability studies shall examine each license type issued pursuant to Sections 15-25, 15-30.1, or 15-35.20, subsection (a) of Section 30-5, or subsection (a) of Section 35-5, and shall be initiated within 180 days from the issuance of the first of each license authorized by those Sections and completed by The results of each disparity and January 31, 2024. availability study shall be reported to the General Assembly and the Governor no later than 12 months after the commission of each study.

The Illinois Cannabis Regulation Oversight Officer shall forward a copy of its findings and recommendations to the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation, Department of Agriculture, the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity, the General Assembly, and the Governor.

(f) The Illinois Cannabis Regulation Oversight Officer may

- 1 compile, collect, or otherwise gather data necessary for the
- 2 administration of this Act and to carry out the Officer's duty
- 3 relating to the recommendation of policy changes. The Illinois
- 4 Cannabis Regulation Oversight Officer may direct the
- 5 Department of Agriculture, Department of Financial and
- 6 Professional Regulation, Department of Public Health,
- 7 Department of Human Services, and Department of Commerce and
- 8 Economic Opportunity to assist in the compilation, collection,
- 9 and data gathering authorized pursuant to this subsection. The
- 10 Illinois Cannabis Regulation Oversight Officer shall compile
- all of the data into a single report and submit the report to
- 12 the Governor and the General Assembly and publish the report
- on its website.

- 21 applications no later than March 15 or the succeeding business
- 22 day thereafter."; and
- 23 on page 148, immediately below line 10, by inserting the
- 24 following:

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"(d) Upon completion of the disparity and availability study published by the Illinois Cannabis Regulation Oversight Officer under subsection (e) of Section 5-45, the Department of Agriculture may modify or change the licensing application process to reduce or eliminate barriers and remedy discrimination identified in the study. Beginning January 1, 2026, the Department of Agriculture shall make the applications available on every January 7 thereafter or, if that date falls on a weekend or holiday, the business day immediately succeeding the weekend or holiday and shall receive the applications no later than March 15 or the succeeding business day thereafter.".
