pedestrians and cyclists. The Department shall develop a policy which ensures the safety of pedestrians and cyclists on roadways within this State. The policy shall provide that improvements will be made during routine maintenance and within a distance of 1,000 feet of the maintenance work to any State roads within a municipality to include, but not be limited to, high visibility signage, crosswalk improvements, curb bump outs, barrier protected bike lanes, and bus

- 2 Beginning January 1, 2024, the Department shall provide a
- semi-annual report to the General Assembly on pedestrian and 3
- 4 bicycle safety improvements on non-highway State routes that
- 5 have been initiated, are in progress, or are recently
- completed. The Department shall provide the reports every June 6
- 7 30th and January 1st thereafter.
- 8 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 9 becoming law.".
