13 Section 20. The amounts appropriated for repairs and maintenance, and other capital improvements in Section 10 for 14 15 repairs and maintenance, roof repairs and/or replacements and 16 miscellaneous capital improvements at the Department's various 17 institutions are to include construction, reconstruction, 18 improvements, repairs and installation of capital facilities, 19 costs of planning, supplies, materials and all other expenses 20 required for roof and other types of repairs and maintenance, 21 capital improvements, and purchase of land.

22 Section 25. The sum of \$6,200, or so much thereof as may 23 be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of Juvenile SB2517 -9- OMB103 00018 MLH 45018 b Justice from the General Revenue Fund for costs and expenses associated with payment of statewide hospitalization.

3 Section 30. The amount of \$415,000, or so much thereof as 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 5 to the Department of Juvenile Justice for the purposes of 6 investigating complaints, evaluating policies and procedures, 7 and securing the rights of the youth committed to the Department 8 of Juvenile Justice, including youth released to the Community 9 Services Division before final discharge.

10 Section 35. The amount of \$62,800, or so much thereof as 11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 12 to the Department of Juvenile Justice for costs associated with 13 positive behavior interventions and supports.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2023.
