The School Code is amended by adding Section 4 22-100 as follows: 5 6 (105 ILCS 5/22-100 new) 7 Sec. 22-100. Retirement savings plans; requirements. (a) This Section applies to contracts entered into, 8 extended, or renewed on or after the effective date of this 9 amendatory Act of the 103rd General Assembly. 10 (b) A school district that offers to the school district's 11 employees a retirement savings plan under Section 403(b) of 12 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, may enter into a 13 contract with only one vendor to administer the plan. A vendor 14 15 shall be selected, with the approval of the employees' exclusive bargaining representative, if any, through a 16

- 1 competitive bidding process. If there is more than one
- 2 exclusive bargaining representative for the employees to whom
- 3 the plan will be offered, the vendor shall be selected with the
- 4 approval of a committee of the exclusive bargaining
- 5 representatives through a competitive bidding process.
- 6 (c) A school district may enter into a contract with a
- vendor under this Section for no more than 7 years. 7
- (d) If, on the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 8
- 9 103rd General Assembly, a school district has a contract with
- 10 a vendor to administer a retirement savings plan under Section
- 11 403(b) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, the
- school district shall, by no later than July 1, 2026, begin the 12
- 13 competitive bidding process established in subsection (b). The
- 14 renewal or extension of a contract with a vendor to administer
- 15 a retirement savings plan under Section 403(b) of the Internal
- Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, that is in effect on the 16
- effective date of this amendatory Act of the 103rd General 17
- Assembly is subject to the competitive bidding process and 18
- 19 requirements under subsection (b).".
