SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/5-5.24a new

Amends the Medical Assistance Article of the Illinois Public Aid Code. Requires the Department of Healthcare and Family Services to adopt rules permitting reimbursement under the fee-for-service and managed care medical assistance programs for remote ultrasound procedures and remote fetal nonstress tests, utilizing established Current Procedural Terminology codes, as published by the American Medical Association, for these procedures when the patient is in a residence or other off-site location from the patient's provider and the same standard of care is met as would be present during an in-person visit. Provides that remote ultrasounds and remote fetal nonstress tests are only eligible for reimbursement when the provider uses digital technology that meets certain criteria. Provides which fetal nonstress test requires a place of service modifier for at-home monitoring in order to qualify for reimbursement. Requires the Department to issue guidance to implement the provisions of the amendatory Act.

4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by 5 adding Section 5-5.24a as follows:

Sec. 5-5.24a. Remote ultrasounds and remote fetal
 nonstress tests; reimbursement.

9 <u>(a) As used in this Section, "CPT code" means the medical</u> 10 <u>billing code set contained in the most recent version of the</u> 11 <u>Current Procedural Terminology code book published by the</u> 12 American Medical Association.

The Department shall adopt rules permitting 13 (b) 14 reimbursement under the fee-for-service and managed care medical assistance programs for remote ultrasound procedures 15 and remote fetal nonstress tests, utilizing established CPT 16 codes for these procedures, when the patient is in a residence 17 or other off-site location from the patient's provider and the 18 19 same standard of care is met as would be present during an 20 in-person visit.

21 (c) Remote ultrasounds and remote fetal nonstress tests
22 are only eligible for reimbursement when the provider uses
23 digital technology:

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1	(1) to collect medical and other forms of health data
2	from a patient and to electronically transmit that
3	information securely to a healthcare provider in a
4	different location for interpretation and recommendation;
5	(2) that is compliant with the federal Health
6	Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996; and
7	(3) that is approved by the U.S. Food and Drug
8	Administration.
9	<u>(d) A fetal nonstress test under CPT code 59025 is only</u>
10	eligible for reimbursement with a place of service modifier
11	for at-home monitoring with remote monitoring solutions that
12	are cleared by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration for
13	on-label use for monitoring fetal heart rate, maternal heart
14	rate, and uterine activity.
