## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 66/60

Amends the Firearm Concealed Carry Act. Provides that a licensee requesting a new license because of a change of name or change of address, or because the person's license was lost, destroyed, or stolen shall submit \$5, which shall be deposited into the State Police Firearm Services Fund.

# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Firearm Concealed Carry Act is amended by 5 changing Section 60 as follows:

6 (430 ILCS 66/60)

7 Sec. 60. Fees.

8 (a) All fees collected under this Act shall be deposited 9 as provided in this Section. Application, renewal, and 10 replacement fees shall be non-refundable.

11 (b) An applicant for a new license or a renewal shall 12 submit \$150 with the application, of which \$120 shall be 13 apportioned to the State Police Firearm Services Fund, \$20 14 shall be apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund, and 15 \$10 shall be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory Fund.

(c) A non-resident applicant for a new license or renewal shall submit \$300 with the application, of which \$250 shall be apportioned to the State Police Firearm Services Fund, \$40 shall be apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund, and \$10 shall be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory Fund.

21 (d) A licensee requesting a new license in accordance with 22 Section 55 shall submit  $\frac{55}{75}$ , of which  $\frac{60}{75}$  shall be <u>deposited</u> 23 <u>into apportioned to</u> the State Police Firearm Services Fund<del>, \$5</del>

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- 1 shall be apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund, and
- 2 \$10 shall be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory Fund.
