Mental health counseling. 8 9 (a) As used in this Section: "First responders" means firefighters, emergency medical 10 services personnel, as that term is defined in Section 3.5 of 11 12 the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Systems Act, dispatched 13 pursuant to a 9-1-1 call, emergency medical dispatchers, as that term is defined in Section 3.70 of the Emergency Medical 14 15 Services (EMS) Systems Act, and public safety telecommunicators, as that term is defined in Section 2 of the 16

1 Emergency Telephone System Act.

2 "Mental health counseling" means counseling therapy
3 sessions provided by a clinical social worker, professional

counselor, or licensed psychologist.

(b) If a fire protection district is a self-insurer for purposes of providing health insurance coverage for its employees, the insurance coverage shall include, on and after June 1, 2025, mental health counseling for any employee who is a first responder without imposing a deductible, coinsurance, copayment, or any other cost-sharing requirement on the coverage provided, except that this Section does not apply to the extent such coverage would disqualify a high-deductible health plan from eligibility for a health savings account pursuant to Section 223 of the Internal Revenue Code.".
