SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes various FY25 appropriations to the Office of the Secretary of State. Effective July 1, 2024.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 140. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the SOS Federal Projects Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for the payment of any operational expenses relating to the cost incident to augmenting the Illinois Commercial Motor Vehicle safety program by assuring and verifying the identity of drivers prior to licensure, including CDL operators; for improved security for Drivers Licenses and Personal Identification Cards; and any other related program deemed appropriate by the Office of the

- 2 Section 145. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as
- 3 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
- 4 of State from the Securities Investors Education Fund for any

- 15 Fund to the Office of Secretary of State for the cost of

- Section 160. The sum of \$200,000,000, or so much thereof
- 18 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of
- 19 State Special Services Fund to the Office of the Secretary of
- 20 State for electronic data processing, for office automation and
- 21 technology, and for operating program expenses related to the

- 1 enforcement of administering laws related to vehicles and
- 2 transportation.
- 3 Section 165. The sum of \$20,000,000, or so much thereof as
- 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Motor Vehicle
- 5 License Plate Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for

- 8 Section 170. The sum of \$4,600,000, or so much thereof as
- 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State
- 10 DUI Administration Fund to the Office of Secretary of State for
- operation of the Department of Administrative Hearings of the
- 12 Office of Secretary of State and for no other purpose.
- 13 Section 175. The sum of \$0, or so much thereof as may be
- 14 necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State Police
- DUI Fund to the Secretary of State for the payments of goods
- 16 and services that will assist in the prevention of alcohol-
- 17 related criminal violence throughout the State.
- 18 Section 180. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
- 19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State
- 20 Police Services Fund to the Secretary of State for purposes as
- 21 indicated by the grantor or contractor or, in the case of money

- 1 bequeathed or granted for no specific purpose, for any purpose

- Section 190. The sum of \$24,300, or so much thereof as may

- of books, records, and holdings; to hold public forums; to
- 14 purchase equipment and resource materials for the State
- 15 Library; and for the upkeep, repair, and maintenance of the
- 16 State Library building and grounds.

 implementing identification security and theft prevention
 measures.
- 9 Section 205. The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary 10 11 of State from the Driver Services Administration Fund for the 12 payment of costs related to the issuance of temporary visitor's driver's licenses, and other operational costs, including 13 14 personnel, facilities, computer programming, and data 15 transmission.
- Section 210. The sum of \$2,100,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Monitoring Device Driving Permit Administration Fee Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for all Secretary of State costs associated with administering Monitoring Device Driving Permits per Public Act 95-0400.

- Section 215. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Indigent BAIID Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State to reimburse ignition
- 4 interlock device providers per Public Act 95-0400, including
- 5 reimbursements submitted in prior years.
- Section 220. The sum of \$45,000,000, or so much thereof as 6 7 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary 8 of State from the Vehicle Hijacking and Motor Vehicle Theft 9 Prevention and Insurance Verification Trust Fund for awards, 10 grants, and operational support to implement the Illinois Vehicle Hijacking and Motor Vehicle Theft Prevention and 11 12 Insurance Verification Act, and for operational expenses of the Office to implement the Act. 13
- Section 225. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may
 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from

 Foundation to help Association members expose Illinois
 youngsters to the game of golf.
- Section 230. The sum of \$160,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from the Agriculture in the Classroom Fund for grants to support

- 1 Agriculture in the Classroom programming for public and private
- 2 schools within Illinois.
