A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The sum of \$70,825,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
7 to the Department of Central Management Services for ordinary
8 and contingent expenses.

9 Section 10. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
10 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes
11 hereinafter named are appropriated to the Department of Central
12 Management Services:

13 PAYABLE FROM GENERAL REVENUE FUND

14 For payment of administrative expenses and claims,
15 including prior years' claims or administrative expenses,
16 under the State Employee Indemnification Act1,445,300

18 Expenditures from appropriations for treatment and expense
 19 may be made after the Department of Central Management Services
 20 has certified that the injured person was employed and that the
 21 nature of the injury is compensable in accordance with the
 22 provisions of the Workers' Compensation Act or the Workers'
 23 Occupational Diseases Act, and then has determined the amount

1 of such compensation to be paid to the injured person.

2 PAYABLE FROM STATE EMPLOYEES DEFERRED

3 COMPENSATION PLAN FUND

4 For expenses related to the administration

5 of the State Employees' Deferred

7 BUREAU OF BENEFITS

18 Section 20. The following named amounts, or so much thereof

7 Governor, may reappropriation not more than one percent of the

11 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated for the
12 objects and purposes hereinafter named to the Department of
13 Central Management Services:

19 Section 30. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
20 as may be necessary, respectively, for the specific purposes
21 of: (1) purchasing and/or leasing zero emission electric
22 passenger motor vehicles; (2) designing and purchasing electric

1 vehicle charging infrastructure and associated improvements;
 2 (3) purchasing batteries, components, diagnostic tools and
 3 equipment to maintain and repair zero emission electric
 4 vehicles; (4) providing supplemental training for employees to
 5 maintain and repair zero emission electric vehicles and
 6 electric vehicle charging infrastructures; and (5) procuring
 7 any goods or services related to converting the state
 8 government fleet to zero emission vehicles are appropriated to
 9 the Department of Central Management Services:

10 PAYABLE FROM STATE GARAGE REVOLVING FUND

11 For all costs associated with converting the
 12 state government vehicle fleet to
 13 zero emission electric vehicles,
 14 including prior years' costs24,800,000

15 Section 35. The sum of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof as
 16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Energy Transition
 17 Assistance Fund to the Department of Central Management
 18 Services for operational expenses and administration of the
 19 Energy Transition Act including state fleet electrification.

20 ARTICLE 2

21 Section 5. The sum of \$2,326,878,700, or so much thereof
 22 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue

1 Fund to the Department of Central Management Services for Group
2 Insurance.

3 Section 10. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes
5 hereinafter named are appropriated to the Department of Central
6 Management Services:

7 PAYABLE FROM ROAD FUND

8 For Group Insurance156,490,900

9 PAYABLE FROM GROUP INSURANCE PREMIUM FUND

10 For Life Insurance Coverage as Elected
11 by Members Per the State Employees
12 Group Insurance Act of 1971.....105,452,100

13 PAYABLE FROM HEALTH INSURANCE RESERVE FUND

14 For provisions of Health Care Coverage
15 as Elected by Eligible Members Per
16 the State Employees Group Insurance Act
17 of 19714,394,810,200
18 For Prompt Payment Interest5,000,000

19 Total \$4,399,810,200

20 The Department, with the consent in writing from the
21 Governor, may reapportion not more than one percent of the
22 total appropriation of Health Insurance Reserve Funds in this
23 section among the various purposes herein enumerated.

1 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
2 2024.
