## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Law Enforcement Training Standards Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, as follows:

20	Section 20. The amount of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof
21	as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Law Enforcement
22	Recruitment and Retention Fund to the Law Enforcement Training

- or retain law enforcement officers pursuant to Public Act 102-
- 3 755.
- Section 25. The sum of \$4,000,000, or so much thereof as 4 5 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business 6 on June 30 2024, from an appropriation heretofore made for such purposes in Article 94, Section 35 of Public Act 103-0006, as 7 8 amended is reappropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the 9 Law Enforcement Training Standards Board for grants to local 10 enforcement agencies for costs associated with the 11 expansion and support of National Integrated Ballistics 12 Information Network (NIBIN) and other ballistic technology 13 equipment for ballistic testing.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2024.
