1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

Section 5. - 6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund

7	be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Research and
8	Technology Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for
9	costs associated with maintaining and updating instructional

- Section 75. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as may 11 be necessary, is appropriated from the High School Equivalency 12 13 Testing Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs associated with administering high school equivalency tests. 14
- Section 80. The sum of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof as 15 16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Community College Board Contracts and Grants Fund to the Illinois 17 Community College Board to be expended under the terms and 18 19 conditions associated with the moneys being received, including prior years' expenditures. 20
- 21 Section 85. The sum of \$625,000, or so much thereof as may 22 be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Federal Trust Fund

- 1 to the Illinois Community College Board for the ordinary and
- 2 contingent expenses of the Board.
- 3 Section 90. The sum of \$1,600,000, or so much thereof as
- 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Adult Education
- 5 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for operational
- 6 expenses associated with administration of adult education and
- 7 literacy activities.
- 8 Section 95. The sum of \$4,264,400, or so much thereof as
- 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
- 10 to the Illinois Community College Board to reimburse colleges
- 11 for costs associated with the Illinois Veterans Grant and
- 12 Illinois National Guard Grant.
- 13 Section 100. The sum of \$20,000,000, or so much thereof as
- may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
- 15 to the Illinois Community College Board for the Pipeline for
- 16 Advancement of the Healthcare (PATH) Workforce Program.
- Section 105. The sum of \$175,000, or so much thereof as may
- 18 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
- 19 the Illinois Community College Board for operational expenses
- 20 associated with the PATH Workforce Program.

Section 110. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for the administration and distribution of grants for the implementation of the Mental Health Early Action on Campus Act.

Section 115. The sum of \$9,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs associated with advanced manufacturing and electric vehicle technologies programs.

Section 120. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs associated with digital instruction for Title II adult education.

Section 125. The sum of \$750,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs associated with the expansion of English-language services.

Section 130. The sum of \$3,175,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for grants and

- 1 administrative costs associated with dual credit grants.
- 2 Section 135. The sum of \$5,175,000, or so much thereof as
- 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
- 4 to the Illinois Community College Board for grants and
- 5 administrative costs associated with non-credit workforce
- 6 programs.
- 7 Section 140. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as may
- 8 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
- 9 the Illinois Community College Board for grants and
- 10 administrative costs associated with the community college
- 11 Homelessness Prevention Grant program.
- 12 Section 145. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may
- be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
- 14 the Illinois Community College Board for operational expenses
- associated with grant management.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 17 2024.
