WHEREAS, Bob Vose was born in Springfield to John and Hedwig (Krebs) Vose on January 19, 1929; he attended Sacred Heart Grade School and Lanphier High School; he served in the U.S. Army; he married Virginia Vetter at Saints Peter & Paul Church in Springfield on May 2, 1953; and

WHEREAS, Bob Vose worked for the Illinois Ice Company, delivering ice for many years before becoming a City Water, Light, and Power meter reader, and later a stationary engineer for the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, Bob Vose was well known as "The Korndog King"; he and his brothers initially started selling Vose Corn Dogs at the Illinois State Fair in 1966; he and his wife, Virginia, continued Vose Fine Food for over 50 years; visiting the Vose Family Corn Dog stand continues to be a statewide annual tradition during the Illinois State Fair; he was given the Illinoisan of the Day Award in 2011 by the Illinois State Fair and was honored to be a grand marshal at the fair in 2017; and

1 WHEREAS, Bob Vose was a proud and active citizen, serving
2 his country and his beloved city; he was the first city
3 alderman elected to represent Ward 5 and continued to be an
4 advocate for his ward and its residents long after his term of
5 service expired; he was a member of the Oak Ridge Cemetery
6 Foundation and was active in fundraising for the cemetery and
7 responsible for Monument Avenue beautification improvements;

9 WHEREAS, Bob Vose was a generous man and donated his time,
10 treasure, and talents to many local causes throughout his
11 life; he loved playing the role of Santa Claus at the city
12 recreation department and was a referee and umpire of high
13 school sports for several years; he sponsored the annual
14 Goodwill client Halloween and Christmas parties for 34 years;

17 65 years; he was a lifelong member of St. Joseph Catholic
18 Church and a proud north ender; and
