WHEREAS, Captain McDermott has worked tirelessly to ensure the safety of his fellow firefighters on the job, serving on the Safety Committee for 25 years and, more recently, leading the effort as committee chair; he also improved departmental operations by serving on the Standard Operating Guidelines Committee for more than 15 years and on the Evanston Fire SR0784
