Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing
5 Section 17-2C as follows:

Sec. 17-2C. Transfer from Tort Immunity Fund by
financially-distressed-school-districts.

(a) The school board of any school district that is 9 certified under Section 19-1.5 as a financially distressed 10 school district may by resolution transfer from the Tort 11 Immunity Fund to any other school district fund an amount of 12 13 money not to exceed the lesser of \$2,500,000 or 0.6% of the value of the taxable property within the district, provided 14 15 the amount transferred is not then required for the payment 16 of any liabilities created by a settlement or a tort judgement, defense costs, or for the payment of any 17 18 liabilities under the Unemployment Insurance Act, Workers' 19 Compensation Act, Workers' Occupational Diseases Act, or risk 20 care management programs.

(b) The school board of any district having a population 21 22 of less than 500,000 inhabitants may, by proper resolution following a public hearing (that is preceded by at least one 23 published notice occurring at least 7 days prior to the 24 hearing in a newspaper of general circulation within the 25 26 school district and setting forth the time, date, place, and 27 subject matter of the hearing), transfer money from the Tort 28 Immunity Fund to the Educational Fund, provided the amount 29 transferred is not then required for the payment of any liabilities created by a settlement or tort judgment, for 30 defense costs, or for the payment of any liabilities under 31
