- 1 AN ACT concerning higher education.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
- 5 Higher Education Institution Crime Statistics Act.
- 6 Section 5. Crime statistics audit.
- 7 (a) On or before January 1, 2004, and every 3 years
- 8 thereafter, the Auditor General shall conduct and report the
- 9 results of an audit of a sample of not less than 6
- 10 institutions of higher education in Illinois that receive
- 11 federal student aid to evaluate the accuracy of these
- 12 institutions' statistics and the procedures used by these
- 13 institutions to identify, gather, and track data for
- 14 publishing, disseminating, and reporting accurate crime
- 15 statistics in compliance with the requirements of the federal
- 16 Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus
- Crime Statistics Act (20 U.S.C. Sec. 1092(f)).
- 18 (b) The reports on the results of the audits described
- in subsection (a) of this Section shall be submitted to the
- 20 General Assembly and the Governor.
- 21 Section 10. Web site link. The Auditor General and the
- 22 Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority shall provide
- 23 on their Internet Web sites a link to the Internet Web site
- 24 of each Illinois institution of higher education that
- 25 includes on that Web site the institution's criminal
- 26 statistics information.
- 27 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 28 becoming law.
