- 8 Sec. 21. Penalty. Any person who violates this Act or
- 9 any rule or regulation adopted by the Department, or who

- 11 this Act shall be guilty of a Class A misdemeanor and shall
- 12 be fined a sum not less than \$100. A person convicted of a
- 13 <u>second or subsequent violation of subsections (a) or (f) of</u>
- 14 Section 4 of this Act is quilty of a Class 4 felony.
- 15 Each day's violation constitutes a separate offense. The
- 16 State's Attorney of the county in which the violation
- occurred or the Attorney General shall bring such actions in

- 25 person violating any provisions of this Act or regulations
- 26 adopted thereunder <u>is</u> shall--be guilty of a Class A
- misdemeanor with a fine of not less than \$5,000.
- 28 <u>2. A retailer convicted of distributing or selling a</u>
- 29 <u>pesticide not registered with the United States Environmental</u>

- 1 Protection Agency and the Illinois Department of Agriculture
- 2 shall be guilty of a Class A misdemeanor with a fine of not
- 3 less than \$5,000. A retailer convicted of a second or
