- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Adoption Act is amended by changing
- 5 Section 4 as follows:
- 6 (750 ILCS 50/4) (from Ch. 40, par. 1505)
- 7 Sec. 4. Jurisdiction and venue.
- 8 An adoption proceeding may be commenced in the circuit
- 9 court of the county in which petitioners reside, or the
- 10 county in which the person to be adopted resides, or was
- 11 born, or the county in which the parents of the such person
- 12 reside, provided, however, if an agency has acquired the
- 13 custody and control of a child and the such agency is
- 14 authorized to consent to the adoption of the such child, the
- 15 proceeding may be commenced in any county, and provided
- 16 further that if a guardian of the person of the such child
- 17 has been appointed by a court of competent jurisdiction, the
- 18 proceeding may be commenced in any county.
