AN ACT in relation to urban problems.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 10. The Urban Renewal Consolidation Act of 1961
is amended by changing Section 4 as follows:

6 (315 ILCS 30/4) (from Ch. 67 1/2, par. 91.104)

7 Sec. 4. <u>Municipal department of urban renewal.</u> The governing body of any municipality having more than 500,000 8 inhabitants, as determined by the last preceding Federal 9 census, and in which there exist both a land clearance 10 commission and a conservation board, by ordinance adopted by 11 a majority of its members, may determine that there is need 12 13 to consolidate the functions of the land clearance commission and of the conservation board in a single body and provide 14 for the creation of a Department of Urban Renewal to operate 15 16 within the boundaries of such municipality pursuant to the provisions of this Act. 17
