- 7 Sec. 6-14. Retail sales on Sundays. No person shall sell
- 8 at retail any alcoholic liquor on Sundays unless authorized
- 9 by general ordinance or resolution of the city council,
- 10 president and board of trustees, or county board, as the case
- 11 may be; provided, however that the city council, president
- and board of trustees, or county board, as the case may be,
- 13 may further restrict the permissible hours for the sale of
- 14 alcoholic liquors under such licenses in its political
