The School Code is amended by adding Section 4 5 18-8.10 as follows: (105 ILCS 5/18-8.10 new)6 Sec. 18-8.10. Fast growth grants. 7 (a) If there has been an increase in a school district's 8 student population over the most recent 2 school years of (i) 9 over 1.5% in a district with over 10,000 pupils in average 10 daily attendance (as defined in Section 18-8.05 of this Code) 11 or (ii) over 7.5% in any other district, then the district is 12 eligible for a grant under this Section, subject to 13 14 appropriation. (b) The State Board of Education shall determine a per 15 16 pupil grant amount for each school district. The total grant amount for a district for any given school year shall equal the 17 per pupil grant amount multiplied by the difference between the 18 number of pupils in average daily attendance for the 2 most 19 20 recent school years. 21 (c) Funds for grants under this Section must be

appropriated to the State Board of Education in a separate line

item for this purpose. If the amount appropriated in any fiscal

year is insufficient to pay all grants for a school year, then
