- 1 AN ACT in relation to labor relations.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Labor Relations Act is
- 5 amended by changing Section 8 as follows:
- 6 (5 ILCS 315/8) (from Ch. 48, par. 1608)
- 7 Sec. 8. Grievance procedure. The collective bargaining
- 8 agreement negotiated between the employer and the exclusive
- 9 representative shall contain a grievance resolution procedure
- 10 that which shall apply to all employees in the bargaining
- 11 unit and shall provide for final and binding arbitration of
- 12 disputes concerning the administration or interpretation of
- 13 the agreement unless mutually agreed otherwise. Any
- 14 agreement containing a final and binding arbitration
- 15 provision shall also contain a provision prohibiting strikes
- 16 for the duration of the agreement. The grievance and
- 17 arbitration provisions of any collective bargaining agreement
- shall be subject to the Illinois "Uniform Arbitration Act".
- 19 The costs of such arbitration shall be borne equally by the
- 20 employer and the employee organization.
