2 AMENDMENT NO. ____. Amend House Bill 920 by replacing 3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 920

4 "Section 5. The Northeastern Illinois University Law is
5 amended by changing Section 25-15 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 680/25-15)

7 Sec. 25-15. Membership; terms; vacancies. The Board shall consist of 9 voting members who are residents of this 8 9 State and are appointed by the Governor, by and with the 10 advice and consent of the Senate, and one voting member who is a student at Northeastern Illinois University. 11 The student member shall be elected by a campus-wide election of 12 all students of the University. The student member shall 13 14 serve a term of one year beginning on July 1 of each year, except that the student member initially selected under this 15 amendatory Act of the 91st General Assembly shall serve a 16 term beginning on the date of his or her selection and 17 expiring on the next succeeding June 30. <u>A student member</u> 18 may serve only for one term. To be eligible to remain as a 19 student member of the Board, the student member must be a 20 21 resident of this State, must have and maintain a grade point average that is equivalent to at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale, 22

1 and must be a full time undergraduate student enrolled at all 2 times during his or her term of office except for that part of the term which follows the completion of the last full 3 4 regular semester of an academic year and precedes the first 5 full regular semester of the succeeding academic year at the 6 university (sometimes commonly referred to as the summer 7 session or summer school). If a student member serving on 8 the Board fails to continue to meet or maintain the 9 residency, minimum grade point average, or enrollment established by this Section, his or 10 requirement her 11 membership on the Board shall be deemed to have terminated by operation of law. If any member of the Board appointed by 12 the Governor fails to continue to meet or maintain the 13 residency requirement established by this Section, he or 14 she membership on the Board within 30 15 shall resign days thereafter and, failing submission of this resignation, 16 his her membership on the Board shall be deemed to have 17 or 18 terminated by operation of law. Of the members first 19 appointed by the Governor, 4 shall be appointed for terms to expire on the third Monday in January, 1999 and until their 20 21 successors are appointed and qualified, and 3 shall be appointed for terms to expire on the third Monday in January, 22 23 and until their successors are appointed and qualified. 2001 The 2 additional members appointed by the Governor, 24 by and 25 with the advice and consent of the Senate, under this amendatory Act of the 91st General Assembly, shall not be 26 27 from the same political party and shall be appointed for terms to expire on the third Monday in January, 2003 and 28 29 until their successors are appointed and qualified. Any 30 vacancy in membership existing on January 1, 1999 shall be filled by appointment by the Governor, with the advice and 31 32 consent of the Senate, for a term to expire on the third Monday in January, 2003. If the Senate is not in session on 33 the effective date of this Article, or if a vacancy in an 34

1 appointive membership occurs at a time when the Senate is not 2 in session, the Governor shall make temporary appointments to fill the vacancy. Members with these temporary appointments 3 4 shall be deemed qualified to serve upon appointment and shall 5 continue to serve until the next meeting of the Senate when 6 the Governor shall appoint persons to fill such memberships, 7 by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, for the remainder of their respective terms. No more than 5 of the 8 9 members appointed by the Governor shall be affiliated with the same political party. Each member appointed by the 10 Governor must be a resident of this State. A failure to meet 11 or maintain this residency requirement constitutes 12 а resignation from and creates a vacancy in the Board. Upon 13 the expiration of the terms of members appointed by 14 the for other than temporary appointments, their 15 Governor 16 respective successors shall be appointed, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, for terms of 6 years from 17 the third Monday in January of each odd-numbered year. 18 Any 19 members appointed to the Board shall continue to serve in such capacity until their successors are appointed and 20 21 qualified.
