AN ACT relating to higher education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Board of Higher Education Act is amended5 by changing Section 10 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 205/10) (from Ch. 144, par. 190)

Sec. 10. The Board of Trustees of the University of 7 Illinois, the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois 8 University, the Board of Trustees of Chicago 9 State the Board of Trustees of Eastern Illinois 10 University, University, the Board of Trustees of Governors State 11 the Board of Trustees of Illinois State 12 University, University, the Board of Trustees of Northeastern Illinois 13 University, the Board of Trustees of Northern Illinois 14 the Board of Trustees of Western Illinois 15 University, 16 University, and the Illinois Community College Board shall retain all of the powers and duties heretofore given and 17 conferred upon them by statute, except insofar as they are 18 limited by the powers and duties delegated to the Board of 19 20 Higher Education by this Act.

Nothing, however, in this Act shall be construed to prevent individual state universities and colleges from establishing higher minimum admission requirements and higher minimum admission requirements may be established for out-of-state students than for Illinois residents.
