- 1 AN ACT concerning higher education appropriations.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 13.5 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 105/13.5 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 13.5. Limitation on appropriations for higher</u>
- 8 education.
- 9 (a) Unless it complies with this Section, a purported
- 10 appropriation of State funds for higher education is not a
- 11 <u>valid appropriation. No State funds may be expended for</u>
- 12 <u>higher education unless the appropriation complies with this</u>
- 13 <u>Section</u>.
- 14 (b) Each appropriation for higher education must be by a
- 15 <u>separate line item appropriation. No expenditure for higher</u>
- 16 <u>education may be funded through a lump sum appropriation.</u>
- 17 <u>(c) An appropriation for higher education means an</u>
- 18 <u>appropriation to or for the benefit of a State-supported</u>
- 19 <u>institution</u> of <u>higher learning</u> for <u>infrastructure</u>
- 20 <u>improvements</u> or <u>operating</u> <u>expenses</u>. "Infrastructure
- 21 <u>improvements" include without limitation capital</u>
- 22 improvements, capital projects, planning, construction,
- 23 <u>reconstruction</u>, <u>equipment</u>, <u>utilities</u>, <u>vehicles</u>, <u>and all</u>
- 24 <u>associated costs. "State-supported institution of higher</u>
- 25 <u>learning" means the University of Illinois, Southern Illinois</u>
- 26 <u>University</u>, <u>Chicago State University</u>, <u>Eastern Illinois</u>
- 27 <u>University</u>, <u>Governors State University</u>, <u>Illinois State</u>
- 28 <u>University</u>, <u>Northeastern Illinois University</u>, <u>Northern</u>
- 29 <u>Illinois University, Western Illinois University, and the</u>
- 30 public community colleges subject to the Public Community
- 31 <u>College Act.</u>

- (d) The purpose of this Section is to require full and 1
- 2 complete disclosure during the appropriation process of State
- expenditures for higher education. This Section shall be 3
- 4 liberally construed to effectuate its purpose.
- 5 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 6 becoming law.
