- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Tri-City Regional Port District Act is
- 5 amended by changing Section 6 as follows:
- 6 (70 ILCS 1860/6) (from Ch. 19, par. 289)
- Sec. 6. Power to apply for and accept grants, loans and
- 8 appropriations; petitions for improvements and changes. The
- 9 District has power to apply for and accept grants, loans, or
- 10 appropriations from the federal government, the State of
- 11 Illinois, and Madison County, or any agency or
- instrumentality thereof to be used for any of the purposes of
- 13 the District and to enter into any agreements with the
- 14 federal, State, and county governments in relation to such
- 15 grants, loans or appropriations.
- The District may petition any federal, state, municipal,
- or local authority, administrative, judicial and legislative,
- 18 having jurisdiction in the premises, for the adoption and
- 19 execution of any physical improvement, change in method or
- 20 system of handling freight, warehousing, docking, lightering,
- 21 and transfer of freight, which in the opinion of the District
- is designed to improve or better the handling of commerce in
- 23 and through the Port District or improve terminal or
- 24 transportation facilities therein.
