The application shall further 6 7 state, under oath or affirmation, with evidence thereof satisfactory to the Department, the amount of funds held by, 8 9 committed to or subscribed to, and proposed to be expended 10 by, the applicant for the purposes herein described and the amount of the grant for which application is made. 11
