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AN ACT concerning health facilities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Health Facilities Planning Act
is amended by changing Section 2 as follows:

8 Sec. 2. Legislative purpose. The purpose of this Act is 9 to establish a procedure designed to reverse the trends of increasing costs of health care resulting from unnecessary 10 construction or modification of health care facilities. 11 Such procedure shall represent an attempt by the State of Illinois 12 13 to improve the financial ability of the public to obtain necessary health services, and to establish an orderly and 14 15 comprehensive health care delivery system which will 16 guarantee the availability of quality health care to the 17 general public.

18 This Act shall establish a procedure (1) which requires a 19 person establishing, constructing or modifying a health care 20 facility, as herein defined, to have the qualifications, background, character and financial resources to adequately 21 22 provide a proper service for the community; (2) that promotes through the process of recognized local and areawide health 23 facilities planning, the orderly and economic development of 24 health care facilities in the State of Illinois that avoids 25 26 unnecessary duplication of such facilities; (3) that promotes 27 planning for and development of health care facilities needed for comprehensive health care especially in areas where the 28 29 health planning process has identified unmet needs; and (4) that carries out these purposes in coordination with the 30 31 Agency and the comprehensive State health plan developed by
