- 1 AN ACT concerning vehicles.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
- 5 changing Section 3-639 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/3-639)
- 7 Sec. 3-639. Special registration plate for a president
- 8 of a village or incorporated town or \underline{a} mayor.
- 9 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees
- 10 and applications made in the form prescribed by the
- 11 Secretary, may issue special registration plates to
- 12 presidents of villages and incorporated towns and mayors.
- 13 The special plates issued under this Section shall be
- 14 affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division or
- motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than
- 16 8,000 pounds.
- 17 Plates issued under this Section shall expire according
- to the multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of
- 19 this Code.
- 20 (b) The design and color of the special plates shall be
- 21 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. Appropriate
- 22 documentation, as determined by the Secretary, shall
- 23 accompany each application.
- 24 (c) An applicant for the special plate shall be charged
- 25 a \$15 fee for original issuance in addition to the
- 26 appropriate registration fee. This additional fee shall be
- 27 deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate
- 28 Fund, to be used by the Secretary to help defray the
- 29 administrative processing costs.
- For each registration renewal period, a \$2 fee, in
- 31 addition to the appropriate registration fee, shall be

- 1 charged. This additional fee shall be deposited into the
- 2 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.
