AN ACT in relation to higher education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The University of Illinois Act is amended by
changing Section 7g as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 305/7g)

Sec. 7g. Tuition waivers. In addition to any tuition 7 waivers that the Board of Trustees offers that are exempt by 8 statute from any tuition waiver limitation established by the 9 Illinois Board of Higher Education, the Board of Trustees is 10 authorized to waive, for <u>persons</u> individuals with 11 the requisite athletic, academic, or other abilities, that 12 13 percentage of its undergraduate tuition that is authorized under the tuition waiver limitation established in 14 regulations promulgated by the Illinois Board of Higher 15 16 Education. If in any fiscal year the Board of Trustees issues undergraduate tuition waivers to individuals in an 17 aggregate amount exceeding the aggregate tuition waiver 18 amount authorized for that fiscal year under the tuition 19 20 waiver limitation established by the Illinois Board of Higher Education, the University's budget request for the succeeding 21 22 fiscal year may be reduced by the Illinois Board of Higher Education by an amount equal to that tuition waiver excess. 23 (Source: P.A. 89-307, eff. 1-1-96.) 24
