AN ACT in relation to criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Controlled Substances Act is
5 amended by changing Section 407.2 as follows:

6 (720 ILCS 570/407.2) (from Ch. 56 1/2, par. 1407.2)
7 Sec. 407.2. Delivery of a controlled substance to a
8 pregnant woman.

9 (a) Any person who violates subsection (a) of Section 10 401 of this Act by delivering a controlled substance to a 11 woman he <u>or she</u> knows to be pregnant may be sentenced to 12 imprisonment for a term twice the maximum amount authorized 13 by Section 401 of this Act.

(b) Any person who delivers an amount of a controlled substance set forth in subsections (c) and (d) of Section 401 of this Act to a woman he <u>or she</u> knows to be pregnant commits a Class 1 felony. The fine for a violation of this subsection (b) shall not be more than \$250,000.
