- 3 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 4 represented in the General Assembly:
- 5 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
- 6 Naperville Park District Tax Levy Validation (1997) Act.
- Section 5. The Naperville Park District having during 7 8 1997 adopted an annual levy ordinance within the time required by law for the subject fiscal year, having levied 9 sums of money as required to defray all the necessary 10 expenses and liabilities of the District for the subject 11 12 fiscal year, and having passed an annual budget 13 appropriation and tax levy ordinance and certified the same to the County Clerks of DuPage and Will Counties, Illinois, 14 15 within the time required by law, the appropriation ordinance 16 and the tax levy ordinance, together with the taxes assessed, levied, and extended thereunder are hereby validated, 17 ratified, and declared to be in full force and effect, 18 notwithstanding that the notice published by the 19 20 District deviated from the notice requirements of the Truth in Taxation Law of the Property Tax Code by: (i) omitting the 21 22 words "or abated" in Division II; (ii) omitting a sentence in Division IV; and (iii) adding the word "Notice" as a title at 23 the top of the notice. 24
- Section 10. Nothing in this Act shall be construed as validating any tax levy in excess of the rate of taxation authorized by law for any fiscal year or for any purpose not permitted by the Illinois Constitution.
