AN ACT in relation to business transactions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business
Practices Act is amended by changing Section 2 as follows:

Sec. 2. <u>Unlawful practice; federal law.</u> Unfair methods 7 8 of competition and unfair or deceptive acts or practices, including but not limited to the use or employment of any 9 deception, fraud, false pretense, false 10 promise, <u>or</u> misrepresentation, or the concealment, suppression, or 11 omission of any material fact, with intent that others rely 12 13 upon the concealment, suppression, or omission of such material fact, or the use or employment of any practice 14 15 described in Section 2 of the "Uniform Deceptive Trade 16 Practices Act",--approved--August-5,-1965, in the conduct of any trade or commerce are hereby declared unlawful whether 17 18 any person has in fact been misled, deceived, or damaged thereby. In construing this Section, consideration shall be 19 20 given to the interpretations of the Federal Trade Commission and the federal courts relating to Section 5 (a) of the 21 22 Federal Trade Commission Act.
