- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Alternate Fuels Act is amended by
- 5 changing Section 5 as follows:
- 6 (415 ILCS 120/5)
- 7 Sec. 5. Purpose. The General Assembly declares that
- 8 it is the public policy of the State to promote and encourage
- 9 the use of alternate fuel in vehicles as a means to improve
- 10 air quality in the State and to meet the requirements of the
- 11 federal Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990 and the federal
- 12 Energy Policy Act of 1992. The General Assembly further
- 13 declares that the State can play a leadership role in
- 14 <u>developing</u> the--development-of vehicles powered by alternate
- 15 fuels, as well as in <u>establishing</u> the--establishment--ef the
- 16 necessary infrastructure to support this emerging technology.
