- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Professional Boxing Act is amended by
- 5 changing Section 10 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 105/10) (from Ch. 111, par. 5010)
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2012)
- 8 Sec. 10. Required licenses. Who-must-be-licensed. In
- 9 order to participate in boxing contests, the following
- 10 persons must each be licensed and in good standing with the
- 11 Department: (a) promoters, (b) contestants, (c) seconds, (d)
- referees, (e) judges, (f) managers, (g) matchmakers, and (h)
- 13 timekeepers.
- 14 Announcers may participate in boxing contests without
- 15 being licensed under this Act. It shall be the
- 16 responsibility of the promoter to ensure that announcers
- 17 comply with the Act, and all rules and regulations
- 18 promulgated pursuant to this Act.
- 19 A licensed promoter may not act as, and cannot be
- licensed as, a second, boxer, referee, timekeeper, judge, or
- 21 manager. If he or she is so licensed, he or she must
- 22 relinquish any of these licenses to the Department for
- 23 cancellation. A person possessing a valid promoter's license
- 24 may act as a matchmaker.
