1 AN ACT in relation to property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Residential Real Property Disclosure Act
is amended by changing Section 55 as follows:

6 (765 ILCS 77/55)

7 Sec. 55. Violations and damages. If the seller fails or refuses to provide the disclosure document before prior-to 8 the conveyance of the residential real property, the buyer 9 has shall-have the right to terminate the contract. A person 10 who knowingly violates or fails to perform any duty 11 prescribed by any provision of this Act or who discloses any 12 information on the Residential Real Property Disclosure 13 Report that he or she knows to be false is shall-be liable in 14 the amount of actual damages and court costs, and the court 15 16 may award reasonable attorney fees incurred by the prevailing party. 17
